ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

PREAMBLE:

This organization is designed to meet the needs of a growing profession. Its intent is to provide an opportunity for women in athletic administration to enhance their professional relationship with colleagues. All meetings are conducted in an open atmosphere and are accessible to non-members through payment of an observer's fee.

- I. NAME: The name of this organization shall be the Council of Collegiate Women Athletic Administrators, herein referred to as the "CCWAA."
 - II. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES: The purposes of the CCWAA are:
 - A. To provide a forum for discussion and debate on those issues and concerns which affect and influence collegiate athletic programs.
 - B. To develop and maintain communication channels among college and university personnel responsible for collegiate athletic programs.
 - C. To provide opportunities for interaction among individuals confronted by similar problems and challenges in collegiate athletics.
 - D. To become involved in the broader perspective of amateur athletics in the United States especially as that relates to opportunities for college athletes.
 - E. To help strengthen collegiate athletic programs particularly as they relate to women athletes.
 - F. To assist in the process of developing the leadership talent of women athletic administrators.
 - G. To assist and lead, where appropriate, the process of athletic governance at the national level.
 - III. CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP: Individuals are eligible for membership in the CCWAA if they meet the following criteria:
 - A. Women who are employed by a university or college in an administrative position in intercollegiate athletics.

- B. Are interested in and supportive of the purposes of the CCWAA.
